- 1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE - none**
- 2. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING** – 15.7.19, These were corrected and signed as a true record of the meeting.
- 3. DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS** – To receive declarations made under the Council's Code of Conduct related to business on the agenda. (Members should disclose any interests in the business to be discussed and are reminded that the disclosure of a pecuniary interest will require that the member withdraws from the meeting room during the transaction of that item of business).
Cllr Allingham declared interest in Planning Application S/2019/1567/FUL.
- 4. PUBLIC** - Members of the public are invited to address the Parish Council on issues on this agenda, or raise issues for future consideration at the discretion of the Chairman. The session will last for a maximum of 15 minutes, each member of the public may speak for a maximum of 3 minutes. Discussion may take place, decisions can only be made on items already included on the agenda. Members of the public may not take part in any other part of the Parish Council meeting. The 2 members of the public expressed no desire to address the Parish Council on any matters.
- 5. DISTRICT AND COUNTY COUNCIL MATTERS ESTATE MATTERS**
Cllr Michael Clarke –
 - County Development – Joint Planning Committee has been resurrected. An estimated 48,000 developments are needed in South East of the county to suit housing need up to 2041. Currently initial consultation is taking place, ending on 11.10.19. Website is: Westnorthantsplan.inconsult.uk Final decisions not to be made for a while. The 'Arc' from Oxford to Cambridge is a

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big development area. The borough is presently not meeting its housing obligation and this is designed to compensate.

- NCC remains delicate in terms of its financial position. It has to save £31m. Predicted overspend this financial year. Unsatisfactory Ofsted report on Children Services. Proposal to set up a Children's Trust which hopefully would enhance the delivery of services and will act under new unitary council.
- West Northants Unitary Council should go live in May 2021. SNC will act as a shadow authority for 12 months. New councillors will work with existing ones. At present the SNC and NCC councillors are working together.
- Cllr Clarke stated that he is no longer on Highways for the NCC but still willing to assist Brafield if required.

6. PLANNING

A) LOCAL

- Update on Fisher German meeting: The Chairman reported that the replacement for Blair Wallace is Tom Short. She is awaiting a response on whether they will put in a full application or a pre-application and whether it will be a joint application with the parish or a solo one from themselves.
- Report and information on local Housing schemes received from Cllr Steve Hollowell offering help on Housing Schemes
- Planning Inspectorate APP/Z2830/W/18/3213262: 24 Church Lane, NN71BA – Appeal dismissed
- Planning Applications on Register below were circulated.

S/2019/1567/FUL – No Objections - **Clerk** to respond to SNC
Cllr Allingham declared an interest and left the meeting while this application was discussed.

B) STRATEGIC – West Northamptonshire Strategic Plan consultation – Council to decide whether to respond.

Only an Issues consultation at this stage. Housing numbers are only noticeable fact at present. Cllrs Ward and Barnell will attend CPRE Planning Roadshow on 10th October. **Clerk** to book places.

8. ESTATE MATTERS

A) FOOTPATHS – Cllr Barnell had written to Cllr Hollowell with concerns about overgrown footpaths. He had responded:

Part of KV6 (Lt Houghton) from its junction with KV17, northeast as far as it enters the old road (Port Lane). This is a headland path and so the highway authority (NCC) are responsible for its maintenance (unlike a cross-field path).

Section of KV6 and that of KC32 which follow Port Lane on land belonging to the trustees of The Davidge Usher Trust. Vehicular highway rights were removed from Port Lane when the new road was constructed shortly before WW2. However, these public footpaths are highways maintainable at the public expense in their own right. The surface of the paths themselves is the responsibility of the highway authority. Side growth is the

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responsibility of the landowner. If the landowner fails to remove obstructive side growth, the highway authority may invoke s. 154 of the Highways Act 1980 which allows them to serve a notice on the landowner giving them 14 days to remove the obstruction. KC2, like the paths above is a highway maintainable at the public expense, therefore, the local highway authority are responsible for its surface -- which in this case, like the Bridle Path, happens to be a bound surface (tarmac).

The **Chairman** will speak to Fisher German using the Land Registry map in the next few days re KC32. **Cllr Copsey** will deal with KC2 with NCC.

The Path Wardens had gone to the exhibition in the Guildhall but reckoned it was not relevant to Brafield and no response was required.

D) PLAY AREA

- Missing plaque, was found to be loose in May 2015 appears to be still missing.
- **Cllr Allingham** reported that she will arrange a meeting with Wicksteed with a view to getting new swings – 2 cradle and 2 flat. Bench also to be installed. Will cost about £10,000. She will apply for a National Lottery Awards for All Grant.

10. HIGHWAYS ISSUES – GROVE ROAD – PREVIOUS REQUEST FOR FURTHER PARKING – Cllr Ward had obtained and circulated title to land. Cllr Allingham reported that no grants were available. Cllr Ward had checked with Land Registry and indicated that any land which would be of any useful size for parking space is now in private ownership. Suggested requesting that GU Homes release the land at top of Grove Road, as they have in Windmill Lane, Denton to alleviate parking pressures in the road. **Clerk** to write to GU Homes. **Cllr Ward** to draft, **Cllr Copsey** will take a panoramic photo to add to correspondence.
