

ALLEY LANE PLAY AREA OPEN

In line with Government guidelines, the village play area opened on Saturday, July 4th. We would ask visitors to adhere to the posters hung at the play area to ensure that the playground is kept safe for the children and that that parents and carers remain cautious about minimising transmission risk. For this reason, we also advise that no more than 8 children play on the large fort in the play area at one time.

GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE ALLEY LANE PLAY AREA

(extract from Gov UK, COVID-19: Guidance for managing playgrounds and outdoor gyms)

- Please wipe down the playground equipment where there are clear touch points such as swing rockers, see-saws, handles or monkey bars.
- We encourage parents, carers, family to bring hand sanitiser gel or wipes to clean their children's hands and encourage hand hygiene including washing/sanitising hands more often than usual, for 20 seconds using soap and water or approved gel and foam sanitiser, particularly at the beginning and end of play.
- We advise users (or parents of children) not to touch their faces, and to cough or sneeze into a tissue or arm when a tissue is not available.
- We would also like to remind adults and children not to put their mouths on equipment or their hands in their mouths.
- We remind users, parents, guardians and carers of the need for social distancing

Also, please dispose of used face coverings and PPE properly in a **'black bag' waste bin or litter bin, and not to put into recycling bins.**

Should the Government provide new guidelines then we shall of course inform you and update the information posters.
